
> FORTUNATELY, THE VIEW FROM THE BUS WINDOW IS **AMAZING**.








THE NATIONAL COUNCIL IS THE **ONLY** CONSTITUTIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE REPUBLIC AND ELECTIONS TO IT ARE HELD EVERY **FOUR YEARS**.

AT PRESENT, THERE ARE ALMOST **70** POLITICAL PARTIES IN SLOVAKIA THAT ARE TRYING TO GET INTO THE NATIONAL COUNCIL.



THE REPUBLIC IS HEADED BY **THREE** CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICIALS: PRESIDENT, PRIME MINISTER AND PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL.

NOTE TO THE HITCHHIKER'S GUIDE,

THERE ARE **MANY ARTISTS** KNOWN THROUGHOUT THE GALAXY AND BEYOND.







Dry land: Most solar energy is changed into *sensible heat*, Wet land: Most solar energy is consumed on vapor water from landscape
